

Toddlers: (18 months to 24 months) Our toddler program offers an environment that encourages independence. We continue to develop large and fine motor skills by introducing table time activities. Our staff encourages creativity and imagination through dramatic play. Toilet training in enforced through hourly routines.

Pre-K2 (3 years to 4 years) Students follow a weekly lesson plan that focuses on introducing new skills. Students are taught the basic stages of fine motor skill (proper techniques for holding pencils and paper), large motor skills (jumping, hopping,

throwing), name recognition (first, last, parent's name), reciting alphabet and numbers and identifying colors and

shapes. Students are encouraged to lead prayers and songs to strengthen independence and leadership skills.

Infants: (6 weeks to 12 months)

In our program infants develop gross motor skills through baby aerobics and hand-eye coordination activities. Language skills are encouraged through prayer and reading

Pre-Toddlers: (12 months to 18 months)

Children in this age group develop large and fine motor skills as well as language skill which are encouraged through prayer, reading, and singing. Children are also introduced to toilet training at this stage. Pre-K1 (4 years to 5 years) Students follow a weekly lesson plan that helps them master the skills introduced in Pre-K2. Lessons focus on language arts, math, science, art and physical education. Communication is encouraged through prayer, circle time, discussion, reading and question/answer activities. Students are encouraged to lead prayers and songs to strengthen independence and leadership skills.
